| \$300                       | Application Fee                                     | Due at time of application.  |
| \$500                       | Review of Home Study (prepared by other agency)     | Due at time of completion of home study.   |
| \$500                       | Dossier Preparation Fee                             | Due at time of completion of dossier.  |
| \$4,500                     | Agency Processing Fee                               | Due when dossier is sent to Philippines.   |
| \$200                       | ICAB Application Fee                                | Due when dossier is sent to Philippines.   |
| \$2,000                     | ICAB Placement Fee                                  | Due upon referral of a child or ICAB approval of match with pre-identified child (add \$1,000 additional for all additional children).   |
| \$4,500                     | Agency Placement Fee                                | Due at the time of ICAB referral/approval.   |
| \$1,000                     | Child's Visa & Travel                               | This is an approximate cost for the processing and bureaucratic fees, documents, passport, visa, and other overseas expenses in getting the child ready to travel. Due when submitting letter of acceptance to ICAB.   |
| \$1,000                     | Child Care Support Fund                             | This is a donation to the child's orphanage to cover some of the costs associated with caring for the child. Due at time of acceptance of child.   |
| \$1,000                     | Orphanage Donation                                  | This supports the orphanage outreach projects of The Sacred Portion Children's Home, specifically the Rehoboth Children's Home in the Philippines. Due at time of acceptance or child.   |
| \$6,500                     | Transportation, Accommodation & In-Country Expenses | This is the approximate cost of both parents' roundtrip airfare and one child's one way airfare, 5 days of in-country expenses and accommodations (applicants pay this directly to airline and hotel) in the Philippines. There will be additional airline expenses for children living outside the Metro Manila area. |

| <b>Other Estimated Fees</b> |   |  |
| \$2,000                     | Home Study Fee                                      | This is paid to an agency in the state where the applicants reside for conducting the home study.  |
| \$170                       | Documents Fee                                       | This is an estimated cost for acquiring certified copies of birth and marriage certificates and notarizations.   |
| \$1,000                     | Medical & Psychological Evaluations                 | This is the cost of physicals required for the prospective adoptive parents and children living in the home and the cost of a psychological evaluation for the parents.  |
| \$945                       | I-800A Application & Fingerprinting Fee             | This is paid to USCIS and is based on two adults; additional persons age 18 and above living in the home would also incur the \$85 per person fingerprinting fee.  |
